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

Guidelines for Selection of Undergraduate Students for Overseas Training programme under IDP-NAHEP

NAHEP provides scope for international exposure to under graduate students under the Institute Development Plan through twinning/sandwich/dual degree programs with reputed international universities. The students for overseas training/internship would be identified based on the overall score obtained by the candidates evaluated as per the scorecard developed specifically for this purpose based on the parameters given below:

- (1) Academic performance (50%) (2) Evaluation of cognition levels of learning in subject matter/specialization (20%), (3) Character, conduct, personality and team spirit (10%), (4) Sports activities (only those which the candidate represented the AU officially) and Extra- and co-curricular activities recognised and rewarded by the AU (10%), and (6) Personal interview (10%).
- (2) The student identified should possess minimum attendance prescribed by the AU in all the subjects.
- (3) **Candidates should possess a CGPA of 7.5 and above and should not have any repeat courses as on the date of cognitive evaluation (examination).**
- (4) As per the existing guidelines, only students of UG for IDP are considered for overseas internship program, who fulfil the criteria of prescribed CGPA Grading of 7.5. However, it has been observed that in many cases, students belonging to SC / ST category are not available with this prescribed CGPA Grading of 7.5 in some of the AUs.
- (5) Therefore, it was proposed to relax the CGPA Grading to 7 from 7.5 for students of SC / ST. While addressing the issue, it is suggested that it should not be done as a blanket relaxation, but first of all, the concerned AU should locate the student of SC / ST as per prescribed norm of CGPA Grading 7.5, failing which, the concerned AU must, after certifying that for maintaining social equity as per laid down Social Equity Plan, no SC / ST candidate is available with the prescribed norm of 7.5 CGPA Grading may send their proposal to PIU for approval for relaxation of such students who have CGPA Grading of 7 which may be considered.
- (6) The profile of the candidates identified for international exposure should be socially inclusive in consonance with the Equity Action Plan committed to the World Bank.

- (7) The final evaluation and scoring for deciding the eligibility should be within the categories identified as per EAP.
- (8) It is mandatory for all the eligible candidates to appear in the cognitive evaluation and personal interview.
- (9) The date for evaluation of cognition levels of learning in chosen/ identified field of training should be widely publicized and separately notified. **There will be a separate cognitive evaluation paper for the students in case under graduates, based on the courses that they have been completed till the on-going semester.**
- (10) A committee constituted by the Director/Vice-Chancellor, would carry out the personal interview of the eligible candidates.
- (11) The identification and selection of the beneficiaries under the programme has to be merit based and transparent as per the guidelines circulated. The selection should be inclusive as much as possible in all respects – social, gender, discipline, etc. Social equity will be followed while selecting the eligible students.
