## Guideline for conduct of Domain Knowledge Test for Recruitment of Assistant Professor in DUVASU, Mathura

- 1. A Domain Knowledge Test will be conducted for Recruitment of Assistant Professor in Mathura.
- 2. The medium of Domain Knowledge Test will be English
- 3. The course curriculum of Domain Knowledge Test should be restricted to the subject and will cover whole of the subject
- 4. The Domain Knowledge Test will consist of a paper of 120 multiple choice type questions to be answered in 02.00 hours. Each question will have four options and candidate will be required to Mark one option.
- 5. Each question will carry one mark with 0.25 as negative mark for incorrect or multiple marked questions. Unattempted questions will be marked as 0 (Zero).
- 6. The Domain Knowledge Test will be conducted in offline mode on OMR sheet.
- 7. Appearance in Domain Knowledge test is essential to be eligible for further participation in selection process. The final score (API score + Domain Knowledge Test Score) will be prepared only for those candidates who appear in the Domain Knowledge Test.
- Admit card for the exam can be downloaded from the university website from 17<sup>th</sup> June, till 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2024 (10.45 AM).
- 9. The key will be uploaded on University website along with the question booklet within 24 to 48 hours after the end of examination inviting objections, if any.
- 10. The objections can be submitted by candidate up to 3 days (72 hours) on the email id (duvasurecruitment@gmail.com) circulated with the advertisement.
- 11. For any objection filed by candidate there will be fee of Rs 250.00 per question. The fee will be deposited in University account and fee receipt/ transaction number communicated with objections. For this the account details are:

- 12. After addressing objections, OMRs will be scanned, evaluated and result will be generated. Mark obtained by each candidate will be converted to obtain proportion out of 40.
- 13. Result will be placed on University Website, inviting objection if any upto three days (72 hours) on the email id (duvasurecruitment@gmail.com) circulated with the advertisement.
- 14. Candidate can file objections to his/her score. Any objection at the stage will be limited to nonevaluation of any question/ totally of the score obtained by the candidate.
- 15. The final mark list will notified and notification will be made in the University Website.
- 16. In any case, the decision of Vice Chancellor shall be final.

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
