ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Uttar Pradesh Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwavidyalaya Evam Go-Anusandhan Sansthan (DUVASU), Mathura was established by Government of Uttar Pradesh through the Act No. 27 of 2001 on October 25, 2001, by carving out all the units of College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry from C.S. Azad University of Agriculture & Technology, Kanpur. The College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, Mathura became its first constituent college. The parent institution of this University had the distinction of being the first Veterinary College set up before independence of India on 16th January 1947. It was the first Veterinary College in Asia to start with degree programme in Veterinary Science and to start M.V.Sc/M.Sc degree programmes in various disciplines of Veterinary and Animal Sciences in 1951 and thereafter started Ph.D. degree programmes.

The University has been named after a great visionary and statesman - Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya, whose native place is in close proximity to Mathura, propounded the philosophy of “Integrated Humanism”. He emphasized that the modern advances in science and technology should be oriented to uplift the economy of rural India and farming community. He was a connoisseur of traditional wisdom of Indian thinkers and a great supporter of natural resource management in crop and animal husbandry.

The mandate of the University is to (a) impart quality education in Veterinary and allied sciences (b) undertake need-based and basic research and (c) provide extension services to disseminate the research findings and knowledge to farmers and livestock owners.

The University, spread over an area of 782.34 acres, is located in Mathura cantonment and is about 5 km from Mathura railway junction and 3.5 km from roadways bus stand. The main campus appears impressive with the buildings of College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, College of Biotechnology, College of Fisheries Science, College of Dairy Science, Institute of Para - Veterinary Sciences, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, University Library, Nand Bhawan, Referral Super-speciality Veterinary Hospital (Kothari Hospital), health centre, educational museum, four guest houses, eleven hostels, auditorium, gymnasium, helipad, residential colonies, herbal garden, nakshatra vatika, street lighting, independent water supply, primary school, medical shop, canteen, bank, ATMs and post office. In addition, the University, on its own campus, has Livestock Farm Complex (LFC) with more than 500 indigenous cows, Murrah and Nili Ravi buffaloes, goat farm having more than 600 goats of ten different breeds and poultry farm with more than 2500 birds, Go - Anusandhan Sansthan, horse stable with riding field and agriculture farm. The other agriculture farm of approximately 1400 acres is located at Madhuri Kund on Govardhan road about 30 km from the main campus.

Being located in “*Braj*”, an area where cattle, symbolized by cow, are held in high esteem, the University is unique in having special responsibilities towards promoting cow husbandry through research and technological interventions.

Placement of the University alumni is a gold standard bench mark of the successful performance of any university. DUVASU has manifested its superiority by way of almost 100 per cent placement of its students in State animal husbandry departments, banks, private sectors, R&D, academic and research institutes, administrative services, Remount Veterinary Services and paramilitary forces like BSF, ITBP etc. DUVASU has come a long way in attaining the objectives for which it was established and is poised to touch the newer heights of performance and milestones of achievements. In recent years, the graduates of this college are coming with new start-ups in terms of small animal clinics and have become job providers than job seekers. During the last almost one decade, students of College of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry have been doing exceedingly well in All India Joint Entrance Examination for Post graduate scholarships/Junior Research Fellowship conducted by Indian Council of Agricultural Research, New Delhi.

The University began a new chapter in its journey by starting with two new colleges- College of Dairy Science and College of Fisheries Science from the academic Year 2024-25. Presently, degree programmes are going on in its four colleges, namely - College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, College of Biotechnology, College of Dairy Science and College of Fisheries Science. In addition to the degree programmes, two diploma programmes i.e., Diploma in Livestock Extension and Diploma in Veterinary Pharmacy are also going on since 2013 in the Institute of Para Veterinary Sciences. The University has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Central Institute for Research on Goats (CIRG), Makhdoom; Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI), Izatnagar; National Dairy Research Institute (NDRI), Karnal; NRC Meat, Hyderabad; NIAH, Baghpat; RAJUVAS, Bikaner; Central Council for Research in Homeopathy, New Delhi; CSWRI, Avikanagar; Sanskriti University, Mathura; IARI, New Delhi; NDVSU, Jabalpur; ICAR-CARI, Izatnagar and GBPUAT, Pantnagar, ANDUAT, Ayodhya, SVPUAT, Meerut etc. In addition, University is also having Memorandum of Understanding with Oklahoma State University, Oklahoma, USA; Purdue University, West Lafayette, Indiana, USA and International Training Centre on Pig Husbandry, Lipa City, Philippines. These MoUs with National and International institutes and Universities have enhanced the research and education opportunities and capabilities for students through their experienced faculty, educational opportunities and laboratory facilities.

COLLEGE OF VETERINARY SCIENCE AND ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

It is one of the premier Veterinary Colleges of the country catering to the need of Uttar Pradesh by carrying out teaching, research and extension education programmes pertaining to

livestock production and health. The college has well established infrastructure and highly competent and experienced faculty. The college has a glorious past and the distinction of having its alumni holding high positions in India and abroad as teachers, researchers, policy makers, consultants and administrators.

All the Departments are having well qualified faculty and excellent laboratory facilities. Apart from this, the College has the Central Instrumentation Laboratory which is well equipped with state-of-the-art instruments, and other research gadgets.

Veterinary Clinical Complex (VCC) of the college is a super-speciality veterinary clinic equipped with modern facilities for diagnosis and treatment of different diseases. These facilities are used for providing “hands on training” to under-graduate and post-graduate students of the college. Round the clock emergency clinical services are also being provided in this hospital for the benefit of livestock and pet owners.

- (i) B.V.Sc. & A.H.: 5½ years degree programme as per MSVE-Regulation 2016 of Veterinary Council of India (VCI).
- (ii) M.V.Sc.: Minimum 4 semesters as per BSMA-2021 regulations of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)
- (iii) Ph.D.: Minimum 6 semesters as per BSMA-2021 regulations of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)

COLLEGE OF BIOTECHNOLOGY (Under Self-Finance Scheme)

The College of Biotechnology was started in 2010 under self-finance scheme with the objective of imparting quality education in the field of biotechnology and undertakes research in Biotechnology and allied subjects, and also to generate competent human resource. The College has competent faculty to run the undergraduate and post graduate programmes and is well equipped with the necessary facilities for teaching and research. Availability of excellent laboratory facilities and experienced faculty of College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry is the added strength of the College of Biotechnology. The graduates of this college have been selected to different National Institutes of the country for their higher studies. At present this college is following the recommendations of the 6th Dean's Committee of ICAR for running the undergraduate programme (B.Tech. Biotechnology) and is following ICAR BSMA recommendations for its PG and PhD programmes. The college has the following departments:

- i) Plant Biotechnology
- ii) Animal Biotechnology
- iii) Microbial and Environmental Biotechnology
- iv) Bioinformatics

The academic programmes offered by this college as follows:

- i. Bachelor of Technology (Biotechnology): 4 years degree programme as per as per the VIth Deans committee report of ICAR and as amended to time to time.
- ii. MSc./ MVSc./ M. Tech. (Biotechnology): Minimum 4 Semesters as per BSMA-2021 regulations of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) as amended to time to time. The candidates with degree of BSc are awarded MSc, while those with degree of BVSc and AH are awarded MVSc and those with B. Tech are awarded M. Tech.
- iii. PhD (Biotechnology): Minimum 6 Semesters as per BSMA regulations of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) as amended from time to time.

In addition, College of Biotechnology is also offering a certificate course from academic year 2024-25 in 'Self Reliant Mushroom Farming'. For details of this course and admission as well as fee details, the candidates are advised to contact Dean, College of Biotechnology. Efforts

are also going on to get the status of this Institute converted to a Public Funded College on the similar lines as other college of the University.

COLLEGE OF FISHERIES SCIENCE

The College of Fisheries Science was started from academic session 2024-25 with the objective of imparting quality education in the field of fisheries and aquaculture and to undertake basic and applied research in fisheries, and generate competent human resource. The college is equipped with the necessary facilities for teaching, research, and farm exposure. The College has following well equipped 7 departments as per recommendations of Vth Deans Committee report of the ICAR:

- i) Department of Aquaculture (AQ)
- ii) Department of Fisheries Resource Management (FRM)
- iii) Department of Aquatic Animal Health Management (AAHM)
- iv) Department of Aquatic Environment Management (AEM)
- v) Department of Fish Processing Technology (FPT)
- vi) Department of Fish Engineering (FE)
- vii) Department of Fisheries Extension Economics & Statistics (FEES)

All the departments are having well qualified faculty and laboratory facility. Availability of excellent laboratory and experience faculty of the college of veterinary science and animal husbandry and college of biotechnology is an added advantage to this college. Apart from this, the college has instructional fish farm having carp hatchery and fish production ponds for field and practical learning. These facilities are used for skilled training, experiential learning and field practical to the students.

The College offers following two academic programmes:

- i. Bachelor of Fisheries Science (B.F.Sc): 4 years degree programme as per the VIth Deans committee report from the academic year 2026-27.
- ii. Master of Fisheries Science (M.F.Sc): Minimum 4 Semesters degree programme from academic year 2026-27 as per BSMA-2021 regulations of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) as amended from time to time.

The college has been offering four years Bachelor of Fisheries Science as per the VIth Dean Committee report from academic year 2025-26

COLLEGE OF DAIRY SCIENCE

The College of Dairy Science was started from academic session 2024-25 with the objective of imparting quality education in the field of dairy science and dairy technology and to fulfill teaching, research and extension mandate in Dairy and allied subjects. The College is equipped with the necessary facilities for teaching, research. The college has been constituted as

per recommendations of VIth Deans Committee ICAR and has five departments and one section, viz.,

- i) Dairy Technology
- ii) Dairy Engineering
- iii) Dairy Chemistry
- iv) Dairy Microbiology
- v) Dairy Business Management
- vi) Pilot Dairy Unit cum Business Process Development Centre

The College offers following two academic programmes:

- i. Bachelor of Technology (Dairy Technology): 4 years degree programme as per ICAR VIth Deans committee recommendations from the academic year 2025-26
- ii. MSc./ M. Tech. (Dairy Science): Minimum 4 Semesters as per BSMA-2021 regulations of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) as amended from time to time. The candidates with basic degree of BSc will be awarded MSc, while those with basic degree B. Tech will be awarded M. Tech.

INSTITUTE OF PARA-VETERINARY SCIENCE (Self-Financed)

The diploma courses in Veterinary Pharmacy and Livestock Extension were started with the financial support under "Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojna" in College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry in 2013 under self-finance scheme and the Institute of Para-Veterinary Science was established. Since then, these programmes are running successfully. Realizing the importance of livestock resources, veterinary education has been strengthened over the years. However, in view of the limited availability of qualified, Veterinarians and trained para-veterinary staff, livestock owners/farmers in remote areas face difficulties in accessing their services. Keeping this in view, diploma courses in extension of livestock services and veterinary pharmacy were started. This has created immense job opportunities for the rural youth. Veterinary Pharmacists and Livestock Extension workers are essential for efficient veterinary services which include first aid and general healthcare and management of livestock including vaccination, artificial insemination in livestock and assistance in public health services and control of zoonoses, endemics and epidemics under the guidance of expert veterinary professional services at village level.

The minimum qualification for appointment as livestock extension officer in Govt. of U.P. is 'Diploma in Livestock extension' as per the government's notification no. 07/2024/I/798726/37-3099/8/2023, dated 18 Nov. 2024. Similarly, the qualification for recruitment of Veterinary Pharmacist is 'Diploma in Veterinary Pharmacy' as per the government's notification no. 01/2025/705/thirty seven-3-2025-2(04)/17/37-3099/100/2021, dated 04.07.2025.

The Institute offers the following two academic programmes:

STUDENT'S AMENITIES

The university provides for facilities for indoor and outdoor games for students. Large play-ground for outdoor games like cricket, hockey, football, volleyball, lawn-tennis, kabaddi, kho-kho as well as, a gymnasium with indoor facilities are available. In addition, indoor badminton hall and squash courts are also available. The university organizes annual sports meet along with the cultural programmes. All the sports events are co-ordinated by Staff Counsellors. Dean Students Welfare is the overall Co-ordinating Officer and In-charge of all such programmes. Other extra-curricular activities such as debates, declamation, quiz, essay writing competition and cultural activities are also organized from time to time.

Tours: Students are sent on compulsory educational tours to National Institutes and Universities as per the Academic Regulations.

AKMU: An Agricultural Knowledge Management Unit is available in the University. All the departments and offices of the University have internet connectivity through LAN System.

Cafeteria/Canteen: Cafeteria / Canteen facilities are available at the campus for students and staff of the University.

Bank & Post Office: Indian Overseas Bank with ATM facility and Sub-Post Office are also located in the main campus of the University. A State Bank of India ATM is also available on University Main Gate.

University Library: University library is housed in a three storeyed building with large number of books and relevant Indian and foreign journals. Library also has the facilities of photocopy machine and computers with internet connection. The library remains open from 10.00 A.M. to 7.00 P.M. A separate book bank also exists in the library with additional facility for the students of the weaker sections of the society.

Students Welfare: The Students Welfare setup in the University looks after the basic amenities for students and ensures facilities and services for personality development and for inculcating leadership qualities in them. Special emphasis is laid on discipline. Students effectively participate in the management of hostels, mess, games and sports, cultural and literary activities and other functions of the University from time to time.

Hostels: The University has eleven (6 Boys & 5 Girls) well-ventilated, neat and clean hostels for accommodating the students. Hostels are provided with Wi-Fi internet connectivity. Each hostel

has common room facility with coloured television, newspapers and magazines. Indoor game facilities for Table-Tennis, Carom etc. are also available. Mess facility is available in all the University hostels. The hostels are managed by hostel wardens under the supervision of Dean Students Welfare (DSW). Hostel allotment is done as per the availability.

Students Council: The University has a student's council which includes the class representatives from different programmes. The President, Vice President, General Secretary and members of the council hold their office for one academic year. The student council participates in organization of all University events. Representatives of the council hold positions in different administrative committees of the University.

NCC and NSS: NCC/NSS is available for each and every student of University. The students have to compulsorily join 1 UP R & V Sqn. NCC or NSS. In addition to routine activities of NCC and NSS, they can also learn horse riding and participate in Republic day parade and various national level equestrian events. NCC cadets of R & V squadron have been bringing laurels to the University in national level events.

Communication Skills and Personality Development Programme: University engages outside experts for improving the communication skills of students and for their overall personality development.

Post Graduate Scholarship Coaching Classes: Every year for the benefit of students, JRF coaching classes are arranged by the University so that maximum students are able to qualify the All-India Agricultural Universities Joint Entrance Examination for Post graduate scholarship which is conducted by ICAR.

Scholarships and Stipends

Merit Scholarships

B.V.Sc. & A.H.: Three students of each B.V.Sc. & A.H. professional year are awarded University Merit Scholarship on the basis of their scholastic merit in their respective classes. Tuition fee of such students is also waived off.

All the students seeking admission through VCI are eligible for National Talent Scholarship of ICAR @ Rs. 3000/- pm., provided they are from the outside state.

M.V.Sc.: One scholarship of Rs. 1000/- pm is awarded to one student in each Department on the basis of merit. In addition, all the students seeking admission through ICAR common entrance test are eligible for National Talent Scholarship of ICAR @ Rs.5000/- pm, provided they are from state other than Uttar Pradesh.

Stipend of the Social Welfare Department: Students belonging to various constituent colleges/Institute of University are eligible to receive monthly stipend and fee refund as per the rules of Government of Uttar Pradesh.

Award of Medals

B.V.Sc. & A.H.: The meritorious students are awarded University Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals and Vice-Chancellor Medal. Various philanthropists and societies have instituted awards for meritorious students viz., Pt. Upadhyaya Memorial gold medal, Dr. Mahipal Singh Memorial gold medal, Dr. P. Rai Memorial gold medal and DUVASU IPSA gold medal and are awarded as per University rules.

M.V.Sc.: The meritorious students are awarded University Gold & Silver Medals and Vice - Chancellor medal as per University rules. Societies have instituted awards for meritorious students viz., DUVASU IPSA gold and silver medal for highest and second highest marks in the subject of Poultry Science and are awarded as per University rules.

Ph.D.: One meritorious student securing highest marks in department of Poultry Science is awarded DUVASU IPSA gold Medal as per University rules.

B. Tech (Biotechnology): The meritorious students will be awarded University Gold, Silver and Bronze medals as per University rules.

M.Sc./M.V.Sc./ M.Tech. (Biotechnology): The meritorious students are awarded University Gold and/or Silver Medals as per University rules.

B. Tech (Dairy Technology): The meritorious students will be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronze medals as per University rules.

M.Sc. / M. Tech.: The meritorious students shall be awarded Gold and/or Silver Medals as per University rules.

B.F.Sc.: The meritorious students will be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronze medals as per University rules.

2. Eligibility Criteria

a. For BVSc and AH

1. The candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English.
2. Candidate must have completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, 2026. Maximum age limit will be 25 years (age relaxation of 5 years for SC/ST/OBC candidates).
3. A candidate under Unreserved, OBC and EWS Category for admission to the Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry degree course shall have to qualify in each of the subjects - English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology, and obtained 50% marks in aggregate in these subjects in the qualifying examination and 47.5% (5% less than the qualifying marks for Unreserved, OBC and EWS category) for the candidates of SC & ST category.
4. For admission to B.V.Sc & A.H programme, the candidates will have to appear in UGEE-2026.
5. For admission to BVSc and AH, the minimum qualifying marks for being eligible for counselling will be 30 percentile for UR/OBC/EWS candidates (20 percentile for SC/ST candidates) in UGEE 2026. The percentile will be determined based on the highest marks secured in the UGEE 2026. Mere obtaining the score more than the qualifying criteria of entrance examination (UGEE 2026) does not give any right of admission to the candidate. However, the University reserves the right to lower the cut-off criteria, if the seats remain vacant.
6. The selection for admission to B.V.Sc. and A.H. degree course shall be only on the basis of his/her merit in the UGEE- 2026 examination conducted by DUVASU, Mathura and reservation as per the State/University Rules and must produce all the relevant certificates at

the time of counselling to be considered under relevant category which candidate has claimed during filling the application form.

7. The candidate must be domicile of Uttar Pradesh and must produce a certificate to this effect issued by the competent authority. (Not applicable in case of NRI/ OCI/PIO dependent /NRI sponsored candidates).
8. Candidates appearing in Intermediate Examination of 2026 are also eligible to appear in the UGEE-2026; however, their admission will also be governed by the above cited rules.
9. In the event of concealing any information or providing wrong information, admission will be cancelled.
10. All admissions shall be provisional in the first instance and the University reserves the right to cancel admission granted to a candidate without assigning any reason.
11. No person shall be entitled to claim any compensation or concession, if the admission granted is subsequently cancelled.

b. For B. Tech (Biotechnology)

1. The candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology/ Mathematics and English.
2. Candidate must have completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, 2026. Maximum age limit will be 25 years (age relaxation of 5 years for SC/ST/OBC candidates).
3. For admission to Bachelor of Technology (Biotechnology) degree course candidate shall have to qualify in each of the subjects - English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Biotechnology/Mathematics. A candidate under Unreserved, OBC and EWS Category shall have to obtain 50 % marks in aggregate in these subjects in the qualifying examination and while the candidates of SC & ST category shall have to obtain 47.5 % marks in aggregate in these subjects.
4. For admission to Bachelor of Technology (Biotechnology) programme, the candidates will have to appear in UGEE-2026.
5. For admission to Bachelor of Technology (Biotechnology), the minimum qualifying marks for being eligible for counselling will be 30 percentile for UR/OBC/EWS candidates (20 percentile for SC/ST candidates) in UGEE 2026. The percentile will be determined based on the highest marks secured in the UGEE 2026. Mere obtaining the score more than the qualifying criteria of entrance examination (UGEE 2026) does not give any right of admission to the candidate. However, the University reserves the right to lower the cut-off criteria, if the seats remain vacant.
6. The selection for admission to Bachelor of Technology (Biotechnology) degree course shall be only on the basis of his/her merit in the UGEE- 2026 examination conducted by DUVASU, Mathura and reservation as per the State/University Rules and must produce all

the relevant certificates at the time of counselling to be considered under relevant category which candidate has claimed during filling the application form.

7. The candidate shall produce his/her mark sheet/certificate of Intermediate Examination at the time of counselling.
8. There is no domicile restriction for admission.
9. Candidates appearing in Intermediate Examination of 2026 are also eligible to appear in the UGEE-2026; however, their admission will also be governed by the above cited rules.
10. In the event of concealing any information or providing wrong information, admission will be cancelled.
11. All admissions shall be provisional in the first instance and the University reserves the right to cancel admission granted to a candidate without assigning any reason.
12. No person shall be entitled to claim any compensation or concession, if the admission granted is subsequently cancelled.

c. For B. F. Sc.

1. The candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology and English.
2. Candidate must have completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, 2026. Maximum age limit will be 25 years (age relaxation of 5 years for SC/ST/OBC candidates).
3. For admission to Bachelor of Fisheries Science degree course candidate shall have to qualify in each of the subjects - English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Biotechnology. A candidate under Unreserved, OBC and EWS Category shall have to obtain 50 % marks in aggregate in these subjects in the qualifying examination and while the candidates of SC & ST category shall have to obtain 47.5 % marks in aggregate in these subjects.
4. For admission to Bachelor of Fisheries Science programme, the candidates will have to appear in UGEE-2026.
5. For admission to Bachelor of Fisheries Science, the minimum qualifying marks for being eligible for counselling will be 30 percentile for UR/OBC/EWS candidates (20 percentile for SC/ST candidates) in UGEE 2026. The percentile will be determined based on the highest marks secured in the UGEE 2026. Mere obtaining the score more than the qualifying criteria of entrance examination (UGEE 2026) does not give any right of admission to the candidate. However, the University reserves the right to lower the cut-off criteria, if the seats remain vacant.
6. The selection for admission to Bachelor of Fisheries Science degree course shall be only on the basis of his/her merit in the UGEE- 2026 examination conducted by DUVASU, Mathura and reservation as per the State/University Rules and must produce all the relevant

certificates at the time of counselling to be considered under relevant category which candidate has claimed during filling the application form.

7. The candidate shall produce his/her mark sheet/certificate of Intermediate Examination at the time of counselling.
8. The candidate must be domicile of Uttar Pradesh and must produce a certificate to this effect issued by the competent authority.
9. Candidates appearing in Intermediate Examination of 2026 are also eligible to appear in the UGEE-2026; however, their admission will also be governed by the above cited rules.
10. In the event of concealing any information or providing wrong information, admission will be cancelled.
11. All admissions shall be provisional in the first instance and the University reserves the right to cancel admission granted to a candidate without assigning any reason.
12. No person shall be entitled to claim any compensation or concession, if the admission granted is subsequently cancelled.

d. For B. Tech (Dairy Technology)

1. The candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Mathematics and English.
2. Candidate must have completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, 2026. Maximum age limit will be 25 years (age relaxation of 5 years for SC/ST/OBC candidates).
3. For admission to Bachelor of Technology (Dairy Technology) degree course candidate shall have to qualify in each of the subjects - English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Mathematics. A candidate under Unreserved, OBC and EWS Category shall have to obtain 50 % marks in aggregate in these subjects in the qualifying examination and while the candidates of SC & ST category shall have to obtain 47.5 % marks in aggregate in these subjects.
4. For admission to Bachelor of Technology (Dairy Technology) programme, the candidates will have to appear in UGEE-2026.
5. For admission to Bachelor of Technology (Dairy Technology), the minimum qualifying marks for being eligible for counselling will be 30 percentile for UR/OBC/EWS candidates (20 percentile for SC/ST candidates) in UGEE 2026. The percentile will be determined based on the highest marks secured in the UGEE 2026. Mere obtaining the score more than the qualifying criteria of entrance examination (UGEE 2026) does not give any right of admission to the candidate. However, the University reserves the right to lower the cut-off criteria, if the seats remain vacant.
6. The selection for admission to Bachelor of Technology (Dairy Technology) degree course shall be only on the basis of his/her merit in the UGEE- 2026 examination conducted by

DUVASU, Mathura and reservation as per the State/University Rules and must produce all the relevant certificates at the time of counselling to be considered under relevant category which candidate has claimed during filling the application form.

7. The candidate shall produce his/her mark sheet/certificate of Intermediate Examination at the time of counselling.
8. The candidate must be domicile of Uttar Pradesh.
9. Candidates appearing in Intermediate Examination of 2026 are also eligible to appear in the UGEE-2026; however, their admission will also be governed by the above cited rules.
10. In the event of concealing any information or providing wrong information, admission will be cancelled.
11. All admissions shall be provisional in the first instance and the University reserves the right to cancel admission granted to a candidate without assigning any reason.
12. No person shall be entitled to claim any compensation or concession, if the admission granted is subsequently cancelled.

3. Application

Applications for UGEE-2026 are invited through Advertisement in National Hindi and English newspapers and also on the University website. Aspirants for admission have to apply online on the prescribed application forms, the details of which are available on the University website (www.upvetuniv.edu.in). The candidate will have to fill the choice of subject in which they wish to appear in UGEE – 2026.

Once application is filled and submitted, the candidate will not be allowed to change the choice of subject. Moreover, the question paper supplied will be as per the choice of the candidate and no option will be given on the date of examination for change.

4. UGEE-2026

The undergraduate entrance examination (UGEE-2026) will be conducted by DUVASU, Mathura for selection of candidates to Undergraduate Degree programmes.

For admission to UG degree programme the candidates will have to appear essentially in, UGEE-2026 which shall be conducted at different centres as may be notified by the University.

5. Admit Cards

Admit card for the Undergraduate Entrance Examination 2026 shall be downloaded from University website www.upvetuniv.edu.in.

6. Examination Centres

UGEE-2026: The UGEE 2026 will be conducted in following eight city centres:

Bareilly, Gorakhpur, Jhansi, Kanpur, Lucknow, Mathura, Meerut and Varanasi.

The candidate will be offered two choices for appearing in examination.

(The University reserves the right to cancel any centre owing to logistical issues/ less number of candidates seeking a particular city centre. In such a case, the candidates shall have to appear in alternate centre allotted to him/ her and no claim shall be entertained for non-appearance in UGEE-2026 (on account of change in centre.)

7. VCI Seats

- a) These seats will be allotted by VCI through its own counselling based on criterion fixed by Veterinary Council of India.
- b) If these seats are not filled by VCI till last date of admissions, they will be filled by the University as per University rules.

8. Payment Seats for BVSc and AH (Other than open and VCI seats)

- a) Candidates seeking admission in this category shall have to appear in the UGEE-2026 conducted by DUVASU, Mathura and qualify the same as per the University rules.
- b) Such candidates would be selected as per the merit list of UGEE-2026.
- c) Reservation policy of the Government of Uttar Pradesh will be applicable for payment seats as well.
- d) Payment seats lying vacant, if any from the reservation quota (EWS/ OBC/ SC/ ST), will be filled from the unreserved category candidates.
- e) Selected candidates shall have to pay Rs. 3.00 lacs in addition to the other fee applicable at the time of admission in 1st Professional of B.V.Sc. & A.H. For subsequent professionals (II and III), including repeat years (failure or drops) in all professionals (from I to III), such students shall have to pay Rs.1.5 lacs per professional year in addition to the other applicable fee/dues. Fee for routine 4th Professional (1.5 yrs) including repeat professional, on account of drop or failure, shall be Rs. 2.25 Lacs plus other normal fee.

9. NRI candidate/ OCI candidate /PIO dependent candidate/ NRI sponsored candidate seats for BVSc and AH

- a) For admission to NRI candidate /OCI candidate /PIO dependent candidate /NRI sponsored category seats, the candidate need not be domicile of Uttar Pradesh.

- b) NRI candidate/OCI candidate/PIO dependent candidate will be given preference over NRI sponsored candidates.
- c) Non-Resident Indian (NRI): An Indian Citizen who is ordinarily residing outside India and holds an Indian Passport. The candidate must produce the relevant documents at the time of counselling.
- d) Person of Indian Origin (PIO): A person who or whose any of the ancestors was an Indian national and who is presently holding another country's citizenship/ nationality i.e., the candidate is holding foreign passport. The PIO dependent candidate must produce the relevant documents at the time of counselling establishing clear relationship.
- e) Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card holder: A person registered as Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholder issued by Govt. of India under section 7A of the Citizenship act 1955. The candidate must produce the card in original at the time of counselling.
- f) For admission to these seats, NRI candidate/ OCI candidate /PIO dependent candidate need not to appear in the entrance examination (UGEE 2026). Such candidates will be granted admission based on the inter-se merit of their qualifying examination (XIIth class or equivalent).
- g) For admission to NRI sponsored candidate, the candidate will have to appear in UGEE-2026 and merit in the entrance examination will be the sole criteria for admission. Moreover, the candidate will have to meet the eligibility requirement as for UR category candidate.
- h) NRI candidates/ PIO dependent candidates must have passed their qualifying examination (XIIth class or equivalent) from outside India to be considered in this particular category. If any such candidate has passed their qualifying examination (XIIth class or equivalent) from India such a candidate will not be considered as NRI candidate/ PIO dependent candidate (However, such candidate may be considered as NRI sponsored candidate subject to production of relevant documents).
- i) The candidate must indicate in the application form to be considered under NRI/OCI/PIO dependent/ NRI sponsored category. ANY CANDIDATE WHO HAS NOT INDICATED THIS CATEGORY DURING THE PROCESS OF FILLING UP OF APPLICATION FORM WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED LATER ON.
- j) Documents to be produced: The list of documents is only indicative and University may demand any other document for satisfaction of the authorities.
 - i. NRI Candidate must produce the proof of passing XIIth class or equivalent examination from outside India.
 - ii. OCI candidate must produce OCI Card issued by Govt. of India

- iii. PIO candidate must produce dependency undertaking from PIO as well as their (PIO) passport (certified Photostat), and certificate from Indian embassy and local authorities (original) where the person is residing and proof of passing XIIth class examination or equivalent from outside India.
- iv. NRI Sponsored candidate must produce the relationship certificate, undertaking of sponsorship, passport of sponsorer (certified photostat), certificate from Indian embassy and local authorities where the person (sponsorer) is residing (original)
- k) The candidates shall have to pay US \$ 8000.00 (or equivalent in INR) in addition to normal fee at the time of admission in 1st Professional year and US \$ 4000.00 (or equivalent in INR) at the beginning of each subsequent professional years including professional years repeated on account of failure or drops except in 4th Professional year where the fee shall be US \$ 6000.
- l) No reservation roster will be applicable on these seats.
- m) Unfilled seats of NRI candidate/ OCI candidate /PIO dependent candidate / NRI sponsored candidate seats will be transferred to UR payment seats category.

10. Women/ Girls Seats

- a) The seats reserved for the girls in B.V.Sc. and A.H. program will be filled under the payment category as per the details given at 8 (e) and as per the merit in UGEE-2026 conducted by DUVASU, Mathura. Girls seats lying vacant, if any from the reservation quota (EWS/ OBC/ SC/ ST), will be filled from the unreserved category candidates (Girls).
- b) The seats reserved for the girls in B.Tech (Biotechnology)/ B.F.Sc. / B. Tech (Dairy Technology) program will be filled as per the merit in the UGEE-2026 conducted by DUVASU, Mathura.
- c) Reservation policy of the Government of Uttar Pradesh will be applicable.

11. University Employee Ward Seats

- a) Only spouse/children of regular employees of U.P. Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Pashu-Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwavidyalaya evam Go- Anusandhan Sansthan, Mathura (DUVASU) are eligible under this category.
- b) For claiming benefit of University Employee ward seat, the applicant has to submit due certificate from University (Annexure K).
- c) The seats reserved for DUVASU employee's wards in BVSc and AH program will be filled under the payment category as per the details given at 8 (e). However, a concession of 50% for class III and IV employees of this University will be allowed in fee i.e., a dependent of employee ward where the employee belongs to class III or IV, the candidate

will pay a fee of Rs.1.5 lacs at the time of admission in first year in addition to normal fees. Similarly, a concession of Rs. 50000.00 for subsequent professional years except 4th Professional where a concession of Rs. 75000.00 will be allowed in addition to normal fees.

- d) No reservation roster will be applicable on these seats.
- e) Unfilled employee's wards seat in BVSc and AH program will be transferred to UR payment seats.
- f) Unfilled employee's wards seat in B.Tech (Biotechnology)/ B.F.Sc. / B. Tech (Dairy Technology) programs will be transferred to UR seats.

12. Reservations

For admissions to B.V.Sc. and A.H., B. Tech. (Biotechnology), B.F.Sc. and B. Tech (Dairy Technology) following reservations policy will be followed in each programme. The reservation will be programme-wise

Reservation for sub-categories is available from the main categories as given below:

- (a) Children of Freedom Fighters : One seat (from any main category)

The candidates claiming for any of the above reservation benefits shall have to submit the relevant certificate issued by the competent authority at the time of counselling.

***Note :** In Physically handicapped sub-category, a candidate shall not be allowed admission to Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry degree course including those admitted under 15% reserved quota of Veterinary Council of India if candidate suffers with the following disabilities:

- (a) Disability of total body including disability of chest or spine more than 50%.
- (b) Disability of lower limb of more than 50%.
- (c) Disability of upper limb.
- (d) Visually handicapped candidates and those with hearing disability.
- (e) Candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
- (f) Disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of the duties of a veterinarian.

The disability will be certified by a Medical Board constituted by Vice Chancellor of the University in consultation with Chief Medical Officer of Mathura District, comprising of at least three specialists out of which two should be of the specialty concerned and the candidate has to

present him/herself before the Medical Board. The fee of the medical board will have to be borne by the candidate only.

13. Syllabus for UGEE-2026

The syllabus for UGEE-2026 will be as that of Intermediate of Uttar Pradesh Board/ CBSE or Equivalent.

14. Question Paper (Question booklet)

a. for UGEE-2026

- The Question Booklet contains 200 questions serially numbered from 1 to 200. There will be 50 questions each from Physics and Chemistry and 100 questions from Biology or Mathematics. The candidate will have to mark in choice of subject on OMR Sheet.
- The candidates aspiring for admission in B.V.Sc. and A.H. / B.F.Sc. has to appear in subject of Biology, while candidates aspiring for admission in B. Tech. (Biotechnology)/ B. Tech (Dairy Technology) can appear either in subject of Biology or Mathematics.
- The OMR Answer sheet/Response sheet is inserted in each Booklet and each OMR sheet has 200 blank spaces serially numbered from 1-200 for filling the answers of respective questions. **NO ADDITIONAL OMR SHEET SHALL BE PROVIDED.** Candidates are advised to handle and fill it carefully.
- The Booklet is stapled, bound and sealed on three open sides with paper seals.
- Question Booklets are in four sets i.e. A, B, C & D.
- In case of any doubt, discrepancy, misprinting, missing pages etc., the candidate must bring it to the notice of the Invigilators within the first 5 minutes and get the question booklet replaced with the booklet of the same series set (A, B, C or D) before writing the answer.
- The rough work should be done only on the question booklets. Extra blank page is provided in question booklets for this purpose. Neither will any separate paper be provided for the same nor will candidate use any of their own paper.
- There shall be four marks for each correct answer and one mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer. More than one answer indicated/marked against a question will be deemed as incorrect answer and will be negatively marked. Zero marks will be awarded for non-attempted question.
- Use only **BLACK/BLUE BALL POINT PEN** for writing and filling the circle(s) on the OMR answer sheet.
- Please read the instructions given in the question booklet in full before attempting the questions.
- The question paper will be in Hindi and English both, however, in case of any discrepancy English version of question paper will be considered to be final.

15. Answer Sheet

The answer sheet i.e., OMR will be provided with the Test Booklet. Candidates are advised to go through it and be fully conversant with the requirement of given particulars and marking the answers so that in the examination hall they could do so without any difficulty.

Note: No query regarding filling up of the test-booklets and answer sheets by the students will be entertained in the Examination Hall. The answer sheet used will be of special type, which will be scanned on Optical Scanner. There will be two sides of the Answer Sheet. Each answer circle on the sheet corresponds to the serial number of questions given in the Test Booklet. With each column, there are four circles bearing letters a, b, c and d which corresponds to the four responses, one of which is correct or most appropriate.

16. Writing of Answers or Responses

There will be four alternative answers for each of the question numbering from 01 to 200. The candidate will indicate his/her response to the question by **completely darkening the appropriate circle with BLACK /BLUE BALL PEN.**

For example, question No. 55 in the Test Booklet reads as below:

College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry of U.P. Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwavidyalaya evam Go Anusandhan Sannsthan is located at:

(a) Lucknow (b) Mathura (c) Bareilly (d) Kanpur

The correct answer to this question is (b) Mathura. The candidate will locate question No. 55 in the answer sheet (OMR sheet) and darken the circle (b) as shown below:



If the candidate does not want to attempt any question, they should not mark (darken) any of the circles given against that question.

The candidate must ensure that the answer sheet is not folded. Candidate should not make any stray marks on it as it may discredit his/her OMR sheet during optical scanning for which the candidate would be responsible.

Wrong/Incorrect way of marking: If more than one circle is darkened or if the response is marked in the manner other than the required, it shall be treated as wrong way of marking the answer. A lightly, faintly or partly darkened or otherwise marked circle will be treated as wrong method of marking which will be rejected by the Optical Scanner.

Various possibilities (Not limited to these exhibited) due to which optical scanner may reject marking. These are only indicative and are not limited to exhibited.



17. Procedure to be followed in the Examination Hall:

- a) Only admit card and pen are allowed in the Examination Hall.
- b) Handbags, Mobile or Cell phone, pagers, digital watch, pen drives, calculators, cameras, tape recorders, pen scanners or any other communication or copying devices are not allowed inside the Examination Hall/Room.
- c) No candidate shall be allowed to enter the examination hall after 15 minutes of the commencement of Examination. Candidates who arrive late may be admitted to the examination hall at the discretion of the Centre Superintendents but in no case a candidate should be admitted who arrives more than 30 minutes after the commencement of the examination.
- d) Before answering the questions, candidates should write their correct roll number both in figures and words on the Question Booklet.
- e) On the front side of the OMR sheet, the candidate should write Roll number, category, sub-category, question booklet code, subject code as well as fill the circles correctly and carefully. Any error in filling circles may lead to non-evaluation / wrong evaluation of OMR sheet
- f) On the back side (second side) of the OMR sheet (answer sheet), candidate should write their name, roll number and put their signature in the space provided as per application form and should be countersigned by the invigilator.
- g) Copying down questions by candidates on admit cards or any other material will disqualify them from the examination.
- h) No candidate shall be allowed to leave the examination hall/room before completion of the examination time. A candidate may be permitted to leave the hall/room only once for the purpose of toilet use after 60 minutes of the commencement of the examination with an escort.
- i) Before leaving the examination hall/room candidates must hand over the question booklet and the answer sheet (OMR) to the invigilator.
- j) Smoking and use of other intoxicants are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall.
- k) University reserves all the rights to get candidates photography and/ or videography and /or finger printing of the candidates during the examination for record and subsequent identification purposes. Any impersonation will be dealt with as per the law.

18. Method of Selection

The admission shall be made strictly in order of merit - cum reservation based on the marks obtained by the candidate in the Undergraduate Entrance Examination. For admission to BVSc and AH/ B. Tech. (Biotechnology)/ B. F. Sc./ B. Tech. (Dairy Technology) merit list of UGEE-2026 will be followed.

18.1. The minimum qualifying marks for being eligible for counselling will be 30 percentile (20 percentile for SC/ST candidates) in UGEE 2026. The percentile will be determined based on the highest marks secured in the UGEE 2026. However, the University reserves the right to lower the cut-off criteria, if the seats remain vacant. Moreover, mere obtaining a score more than the qualifying criteria of entrance examination (UGEE 2026) does not give any right of admission to the candidate. The candidate must be in the merit list to be eligible for counselling and produce all the relevant certificates at the time of counselling to be considered under relevant category which the candidate has claimed during filling the application form.

18.2. In case of candidates having obtained equal percentile in the entrance examination, their inter-se ranking shall be determined on the basis of the following:

- a) The aggregate percent of marks obtained by the candidates in all the subjects taken by him/ her in Intermediate/ (10+2) examination.
- b) The aggregate of the percent marks obtained in science subjects (physics, chemistry, biotechnology/biology/mathematics) in Intermediate/ (10+2) examination.
- c) In case of the candidates, who have secured equal marks in aggregate at the qualifying examinations as well as in science subjects, and even other examinations up to high school examinations, the date of birth shall be the basis i.e., the candidate senior in age would rank higher for selection.

- a) If any seat of ICAR category is left unfilled, it will be filled by University through PGEE-2026.

- b) The University reserves right to increase number of seats in doctorate programme in a particular discipline by shifting of seats left vacant in different discipline. The shifting of seats in different disciplines will be decided by the Committee constituted by Vice-Chancellor. The Committee after assessing the availability of required faculty and facilities will make recommendation. The recommendation of the Committee shall be put up to Vice-chancellor for approval.

- ii. For admission on Masters Programme of Veterinary Sciences, the candidate must have passed the B.V.Sc & A.H. examination from a VCI recognized veterinary college. The applications of employed candidates must be routed through their employer, failing which the same will not be entertained.
- iii. Eligibility for Masters Programme (in College of Veterinary Science and AH) is BVSc and AH with 6.000/10.000 or equivalent OGPA/equivalent percentage of marks for un-reserved, OBC and EWS category candidates and 5.500/10 or equivalent OGPA/equivalent percentage of marks for SC/ST/PH category candidates.
- iv. For the College of Biotechnology, the master's degree nomenclature shall be M.Tech. if the bachelor degree is B.Tech.; MSc if the bachelor degree is B.Sc and MVSc if the bachelor degree is BVSc & AH.
- v. The eligibility qualification for master's and doctorate programme in college of Biotechnology will be as follows:

- viii. Eligibility for Doctorate programme (in College of Veterinary Science and AH) is MVSc in the concerned subject with a minimum OGPA of 6.500/10.000 or equivalent percentage of marks for un- reserved (UR), OBC and EWS category candidates and 6.000/10.000 for SC/ST/PH category candidates.
- ix. Conversion formula for OGPA calculation shall be of the respective university and of the same year in which the candidate has obtained degree. For this, the candidate will have to submit the same in form of a certificate duly authenticated by Registrar/ Dean of the concerned University.
- x. Admission to all Post-graduate programmes shall be made strictly on the basis of merit in the Post Graduate Entrance Examination 2026 (PGEE-2026) conducted by DUVASU, Mathura.
- xi. Mere appearance/ qualifying/ merit in PGEE-2026 does not make the candidate eligible for admission in Post graduate courses unless candidate has not passed the undergraduate degree on the date of registration.
- xii. The candidate will have to produce certificate of qualifying the pre-requisite degree on the date of counselling. - xix. For Ph.D. programme, candidates who qualify SRF of ICAR and in-service candidates of other SAUs / SVUs / ICAR and of DUVASU will not be required to appear in the PG Entrance Examination and their seats shall be over and above the seats shown above in table.
- xx. Result of qualified candidates in PGEE-2026 will be communicated through University website. No separate counselling letters will be issued.
- xxi. The allocation of the discipline to a candidate shall be made at the time of counselling according to the merit obtained in the PGEE-2026.
- xxii. The candidates once allotted a seat in any programme of the University shall be required to deposit the fees on the date of admission. If any candidate fails to deposit the fee after allotment of a seat, seat shall stand cancelled automatically and the same will be allotted to next candidate according to merit.

Sc. as per recommendations of Vth Deans committee report of the ICAR.
- vi. The maximum marks for question paper shall be 200.

- vii. There is no negative marking.
- viii. The OMR Answer sheet/Response sheet is inserted in each Booklet and each OMR sheet has 200 blank spaces serially numbered from 1-200 for filling the answers of respective questions. **NO ADDITIONAL OMR SHEET SHALL BE PROVIDED.** Candidates are advised to handle and fill it carefully.
- ix. The Booklet is stapled, bound and sealed on three open sides with paper seals.
- x. Question Booklets shall be in four sets i.e. A, B, C & D.
- xi. In case of any doubt, discrepancy, misprinting, missing pages etc., the candidate must bring it to the notice of the Invigilators within the first five minutes and get question booklet replaced with the booklet of the same set (A, B, C or D) before writing the answer.
- xii. More than one answer indicated/marked against a question will be deemed as incorrect answer.

- vii. In case of any doubt, discrepancy, misprinting, missing pages etc., the candidate must bring it to the notice of the Invigilators within the first five minutes and get question booklet replaced.
- viii. There will be four alternative answers for each of the question numbering from 01 to 100. The candidate will indicate his/her response to the question in the provided space.

- ix. The rough work should be done only on the question booklets. Extra blank page is provided in question booklets for this purpose. Neither will be provided any separate paper nor will they use any of their own paper.

d. Procedure to be followed in the Examination Hall

- i. Only admit card and pen are allowed in the Examination Hall.

- b) The aggregate percent of marks obtained by the candidates in Intermediate/ (10+2) examination.
- c) The aggregate of the percent marks obtained in high school examination.
- d) In case of the candidates, who have secured equal marks in aggregate at the qualifying examinations, and even other examinations up to high school examinations, the date of birth shall be the basis i.e., the candidate senior in age would rank higher for selection.

(B) Admission to doctorate programmes: Admission to PhD programme shall be made strictly in order of merit - cum reservation based on the marks obtained by the candidate in the Postgraduate Entrance Examination i.e., PGEE-2026.

The correct answer to this question is (b) Mathura. The candidate will locate question No. 55 in the answer sheet and darken the circle (b) as shown below:



If the candidate does not want to attempt any question, they should not mark (darken) any of the circles given against that question.

The candidate must ensure that the answer sheet is not folded. The candidate should not make any stray marks on it as it may discredit his/her OMR sheet during optical scanning for which the candidate would be responsible.

Wrong/Incorrect way of marking: If more than one circle is darkened or if the response is marked in the manner other than the required, it shall be treated as wrong way of marking the answer. A lightly, faintly or partly darkened or otherwise marked circle will be treated as wrong method of marking which will be rejected by the Optical Scanner.

Various possibilities (Not limited to these exhibited) due to which optical scanner may reject marking. These are only indicative and are not limited to exhibited.



12. Procedure to be followed in the Examination Hall:

- Only admit card and pen are allowed in the Examination Hall.
- Handbags, Mobile or Cell phone, pagers, digital watch, pen drives, calculators, cameras, tape recorders, pen scanners or any other communication or copying devices are not allowed inside the Examination Hall/Room.
- No candidate shall be allowed to enter the examination hall after 15 minutes of the commencement of Examination. Candidates who arrive late may be admitted to the examination hall at the discretion of the Centre Superintendents but in no case a candidate should be admitted who arrives more than 30 minutes after the commencement of the examination.
- Before answering the questions, candidates should write their correct Roll Number both in figures and words on the Question Booklet and Roll Number, Category, Sub-category and Code of question booklet and mark proper circles on front side of OMR sheet and on

second side put up their Name and Signature. Any error in this will lead to non-evaluation of the OMR sheet.

- e) On the back side of the OMR sheet (answer sheet), candidate should write their name and put signature in the space provided as per application form and should be countersigned by the invigilator.
- f) On the front side of the OMR sheet, the candidate should write Roll number, category, sub-category, question booklet code as well as fill the circles correctly and carefully. Any error in filling circles may lead to non-evaluation / wrong evaluation of OMR sheet
- g) Copying down questions by candidates on admit cards or any other material will disqualify them from the examination.
- h) No candidate shall be allowed to leave the examination hall/room before completion of the examination time. A candidate may be permitted to leave the hall/room only once for the purpose of toilet use after 60 minutes of the commencement of the examination with an escort.
- i) Before leaving the examination hall/room candidates must hand over the question booklet and the answer sheet (OMR) to the invigilator.
- j) Smoking and use of other intoxicants are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall.

13. Method of Selection

(i) The admission shall be made strictly in order of merit - cum reservation based on the aggregate marks obtained by candidate in DEE-2026.

(ii) The minimum qualifying marks for being eligible for counselling of Diploma programme will be 30 percentile (20 percentile for SC/ST candidates) in DEE 2026. The percentile will be determined based on the highest marks secured in the DEE 2026. However, the University reserves the right to lower the cut-off criteria, if the seats remain vacant. Moreover, mere obtaining a score more than the qualifying criteria of entrance examination (DEE 2026) does not give any right of admission to the candidate. The candidate must be in the merit list to be eligible for counselling and produce all the relevant certificates at the time of counselling to be considered under relevant category which candidate has claimed during filling the application form.

(iii) In case of candidates having obtained equal marks in the entrance examination, their inter-se ranking shall be determined on the basis of the following:

- a) The aggregate percent of marks obtained by the candidates in Intermediate/(10+2) examination.
- b) The aggregate of the percent marks obtained in science subjects (physics, chemistry, Biotechnology/biology) in Intermediate/(10+2) examination.

- c) In case of the candidates, who have secured equal marks in aggregate at the qualifying examinations as well as in science subjects, and even other examinations up to high school examinations, the date of birth shall be the basis i.e., the candidate senior in age would rank higher for selection.

D. COUNSELLING:

The university will strive to conduct counselling in online mode. However, if required the counselling will be conducted in offline mode at University headquarters. The information will be provided on University website. The candidates are strongly advised to view University website regularly for updates.

1. Offline Counselling: The University will conduct Offline counselling. If offline counselling is conducted, the candidate will have to pay counselling fees of Rs. 500.00 (Non-refundable) only to participate in counselling at the counter for this purpose on the day of counselling. Further, the candidate will have to deposit full fees at the time of admission for the seat against which candidate have been admitted. Offline counselling can be conducted in multiple rounds and any seat remaining vacant will be taken to next round of counselling and filled. The candidates will have to regularly check for updates on University website for information regarding dates of counselling rounds and other details.

2. Online Counselling: The University will attempt to conduct online counselling, for which detailed guidelines will be placed on website. The candidates are strongly advised to visit the university website regularly and keep themselves abreast with the information. No complaint/petition will be entertained on account of this. If online counselling is conducted, following will be the brief guidelines:

- a) There will be two stages of Counselling. First Stage will be Online counselling which will be conducted in various rounds. The second stage will be Offline counselling which will be conducted at University headquarters.
- b) Online Counselling will be done for admission to all programmes.
- c) The schedule and other details will be made available on University website as the result of UGEE-2026/ PGEE-2026/ DEE-2026 will be declared.
- d) The candidate will keep themselves updated by frequently visiting the University website for details and procedure of counselling whenever declared.
- e) The University will not send individual notice of counselling to any candidate.
- f) No appeal shall be entertained for non- participation in counselling on want of non-information on part of University.
- g) For online counselling, interested candidate will have to login on University website after declaration of Result (UGEE/PGEE/DEE) and pay a counselling fees of Rs. 500.00

only {plus Payment Gateway (PG) charges, if any}. This payment will be by online mode only and will be non-refundable.

- h) The online counselling will be conducted in different stages and candidates will have to participate in various stages for allotment of seat. The seat will be allotted according to choice filled, merit and category.
- i) The allotment of seat will be provisional and will be subject to deposition of seat acceptance fee of Rs. 5000.00 (plus PG Charges, if any) at the time of allotment. The deposition of fees will be in online mode only.
- j) On deposition of seat acceptance fee, the candidate will get the option of either remaining at the same seat or apply for upgradation.
- k) For consideration of candidature for seat upgradation, deposition of seat acceptance fees is essential.
- l) The confirmation of provisional admission will be subject to subsequent verification of documents at the time of admission.
- m) If any candidate does not deposit the seat acceptance fees or is not able to deposit seat acceptance fees due to any reason (including transaction failure), the allotment of seat will be cancelled automatically and no appeal will be entertained for the same.
- n) The seat acceptance fee will be adjusted against final payment at the time of admission. However, if the admission is not finally granted due to lack of documents or misrepresentation of facts by the candidate the seat acceptance fee will not be refunded nor adjusted for any other candidate and will stand forfeited.
- o) After completion of online counselling, a round of offline counselling will be conducted at University campus on the date declared.
- p) Candidates who have participated in online counselling but could not get admission will be eligible to participate in Offline counselling on seats left vacant. The admission will be granted subject to merit, choice of course, and category; production of appropriate certificates and deposition of fees. The details including procedure and fees etc., about the offline counselling will be shared on University website.
- q) If required, a mop-up round of counselling will be conducted after offline counselling. The mop-up round will be in offline mode and will be conducted at University headquarters. The details including procedure and fees etc., about the mop-up round counselling will be shared on University website.

3. Documents to be produced at the time of counselling:

The candidates will have to essentially produce following documents:

- a) Certificate to the effect that the candidate has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology/ Mathematics and English from recognized board.
- b) Admit card issued by the University for appearing in the entrance examination.

- c) Statement of marks of 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology/ Mathematics and English from recognized board.
- d) Class Xth / Equivalent certificate from relevant board of examination stating the date of birth
- e) Domicile certificate issued by the competent authority (Not required for admission in college of biotechnology)
- f) Character Certificate issued by the last institution attended. If the Character certificate is more than 6 months old, then in that case Character certificate issued by a gazetted officer can be submitted. In such case, it must bear clear address, dispatch number and date (certificate number) of the issuing authority.
- g) Migration certificate and /or Transfer certificate from the last institution attended.
- h) Category certificate in case of SC /ST/ OBC / EWS Category issued by the competent authority.
- i) Subcategory certificate in case of PH/FF/AF issued by the competent authority
- j) Certificate from employer (Veterinary University, Mathura) in case of University employee ward.
- k) Income certificate of guardian/ parents issued by the competent authority
- l) For NRI candidate /OCI candidate /PIO dependent candidate: Original and Photocopy of the relevant certificates.
- m) For NRI sponsored candidates- letter from the sponsor (In original and photocopies), passport of sponsor (Photostat and attested copy) and proof of residence of sponsor (Photostat and attested copy).
- n) For candidates seeking admission in PG/ PhD courses, candidate will have to produce the certificate that candidate has passed the qualifying degree examination. However, if the candidate is yet to complete the qualifying degree requirements on date of counselling they can be granted provisional admission based on the certificate from Registrar/ Dean, of their place of study, stating that ‘_____ (Name of candidate) is expected to complete the requirements of pre-requisite degree before the date of registration (_____) (mention date of completion of degree)’.
- o) All annexures as per the prospectus (Annexure G, G(a), G(b), H and I)

E. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:

- a) All the candidates desirous of seeking admission will have to undergo medical examination at the time of admission.
- b) The medical examination will be conducted at the University headquarters at the time of admission/counselling.
- c) The medical certificate will be as per the proforma given in the prospectus.

- d) The fees for same will be Rs. 100.00 per candidate and will be borne by the candidate, which will be realized along with the admission fees and paid to CMO/MO nominated by CMO, Mathura on production of bill for the same by CMO/ MO

F. FEE STRUCTURE AND DEPOSITION

1. Application fee Deposition:

- The Application processing fees for UGEE/PGEE/DEE is non-refundable.
- The candidate will have to submit separate application form for UGEE/ PGEE/DEE.
- The fees will be paid online and no-other mode of fee payment is accepted.

2. Course fees Deposition:

- The admission to all courses will be through admission test and subsequent online/ offline counselling.
- The schedule and procedure for online counselling will be circulated through University website. The candidates are advised to check website regularly for details and updates.
- The candidate will have to deposit seat acceptance fees during the online counselling.
- If the candidate subsequently does not take admission on the seat allotted, the seat acceptance fees will be forfeited and in no case refunded.
- If the candidate takes admission on the seat allotted, the seat acceptance fees will be adjusted towards the fees to be deposited by the candidate.
- If the candidate is upgraded according to their choice and merit, the candidate will have to deposit the fees according to the seat freshly allotted to the candidate. If the fees of the fresh seat allotted to the candidate is lower than the original seat allotted then, he need not to deposit fees, however, the fees will be adjusted in next semester/ professional year.

3. Fees refund regulations:

Since no further admission will be conducted after the last date of physical counselling/ Mop up round, and seats vacated after the last date of physical counselling/ Mop up round will remain vacant for the admission year 2026-27, the following regulations will apply for refund of fees for the admission year 2026-27.

- For cancellation of any admission, Rs. 1000.00 (Rs. One Thousand only) will be deducted as processing charges. However, if any candidate shifts from one allotted seat after admission to another seat, no processing charges will be deducted.
- The fees deposited will be refunded as follows:

Seat vacated 15 days or more before the last date of admission	100%
Seat vacated less than 15 days before the last date of admission	90%
Seat vacated less than 15 days after the last date of admission	80%
Seat vacated more than 15 days but less than 30 days after the last date of admission	50%
Seat vacated more than 30 days after the last date of admission	00%

Note: 1. Last date of physical counselling/ Mop up round will be the last date of admission

2. Processing charges will be over and above the refunded amount.

- c. To ensure that any frivolous application is not made or prevent any kind of impersonation, the candidate himself/ herself has to be present and submit the application in hard copy for cancellation of admission. E-mail/ telephonic/ whatsapp or any electronic requests will not be entertained.
- d. For cancellation of admission, the candidate will have to submit the complete application in all respect and clear all the dues (if any) before it is taken up for processing the cancellation. Incomplete applications will not be entertained.
- e. The refundable deposit (Caution money, Library security and Hostel security) will be refunded fully to the candidate and will not be counted towards calculation of above.
- f. The fees and all other refunds will be credited electronically to only the bank account of the candidate. The candidate will have to submit a cancelled cheque of the bank account along with the application.

4. Fees Deposition for continuing students:

- a. The fees will have to be deposited by all the students at the beginning of each semester/ professional year at the time of registration of semester/ professional year as the case may be.
- b. However, candidates belonging to SC/ ST category will have to produce the freeship card at the time registration of the semester/ professional year from second year of their study onwards as per the rules and directions of the Govt. of UP.

PAYMENT OF FEES AND OTHER DUES

Once the final admission is granted, the candidate is required to deposit the fees in cash or in the form of demand draft in favour of “**Finance Officer, Veterinary University, Mathura**” payable at **Mathura**. The candidate can also deposit the fees through **RTGS/ NEFT**. The

admission of a candidate, who does not deposit the fee after allocation of the seat, shall automatically stand cancelled. The account details for RTGS/ NEFT will be available on University website along with the notification of counselling.

REQUIREMENT OF ATTENDANCE

All the programmes offered by the University are in regular mode only. No programme is offered in distance mode/ open and distance learning mode. Each student shall be regular in attending the classes and shall be required to have a minimum of 75% attendance, both in theory and practical separately, in each course in each semester/ year/ professional year. If they fail to have 75% attendance, they will be debarred from appearing in the semester/ annual/ professional examination. On account of this, they have to repeat the course(s) in the subsequent semesters/year/ professional year as per the relevant regulations.

IMPORTANT GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. Candidates must read the instructions given in the PROSPECTUS very carefully. The application form must be completed in all respects.
2. Only online application form will be accepted.
3. Consideration of on-line application is subject to successful transaction of the requisite fee to the University account.
4. Original certificates will have to be produced at the time of off line counselling.
5. Concealing of any information will be treated as misconduct and action will be taken as per the Rules of the University. Admission of such candidate(s) would be cancelled.
6. All admissions shall be provisional and the University reserves the right to cancel any admission granted to a candidate without assigning any reason thereof.
7. The candidate should upload their recent coloured passport size photograph with date in full front pose (not profile) without any cap and/or sunglasses in the application form at the specified place.
8. The candidate should ascertain that they fulfil the eligibility requirement for admission/appearing in the Entrance Examination as the fees once paid shall not be refunded in the event of rejection.
9. The candidate is advised to clearly mention their complete mailing address in the application form.
10. Applications received after last date will not be entertained and no claim what-so-ever can be made for such applications.
11. The decision of the University in all matters related to Entrance Examination/Admission shall be final.
12. Use of unfair means in the Entrance Examination will be dealt with as per the University Rules. The University shall cancel result of such candidates.
13. Candidate seeking reservation should clearly mention their category/sub-category in the application form and also answer sheets / OMR sheets in the entrance-examination.
14. In UGEE/PGEE/DEE, the candidate will use only BALL PEN (BLACK/BLUE) for filling up circles on answer sheet (OMR).
15. After the examination is over, the candidate will be responsible to hand over their answer sheet along with the question booklet to the Invigilator; otherwise, their candidature shall be rejected.
16. The rough work should be done only on the question paper. For this purpose, neither will any separate paper provided nor will they use any of their own paper. Only admission card will be allowed in the examination hall.
17. Scrutiny/re-evaluation of answer sheet of the entrance examination is not allowed.
