

SCOPE OF WORK

The scope shall include:

- Supply and installation of Industrial RO plants (capacity as per hostel strength)
- Supply and installation of raw, treated water storage tanks & water chillers if necessary
- Provision of raw and treated water storage tanks
- Complete plumbing & electrical integration
- Daily operation & monitoring
- Preventive and breakdown maintenance
- Replacement of membranes, filters, UV lamps, pumps, compressors and other spare parts for uninterrupted water supply
- Periodic water quality testing (NABL certified)
- Deployment of dedicated technician
- 24x7 complaint support

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. **Nature of Contract:** This shall be a service contract on monthly rental basis. The successful bidder shall provide, install, operate, maintain, and replace all components of the RO systems and water chillers at its own cost. The University shall provide only designated space, electricity and raw water connection.

2. **Scope & Responsibility:** The service provider shall be fully responsible for:

- Installation and commissioning of RO plants, raw and treated water storage tanks and chillers. The successful bidder shall install and commission the RO system at the specified location within 15 days from the date of issue of work order.
- All plumbing, storage tanks, electrical integration from designated power point
- Operation and preventive maintenance
- Replacement of membranes, filters, pumps, compressors, UV systems, panels, and all components.
- Deployment of technical manpower.
- 24x7 complaint support.
- The University shall not bear any capital, maintenance, repair or consumable.

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Water Quality & Health Safety: The service provider shall ensure that drinking water strictly complies with BIS IS 10500 (latest revision) standards at all times. In case of contamination, health hazard, or failure of purification:

- The entire responsibility shall rest with the service provider.
- The service provider shall indemnify the University from all legal, civil, or statutory liabilities.
- The University may terminate the contract and forfeit Performance Security.
- The bidder shall maintain adequate liability insurance.

4. Service Levels & Downtime

- Maximum downtime per complaint: 24 hours
- Repeated failure (12 or more instances in a year) may lead to termination
- Monthly payment shall be released only after certification by the officer nominated by competent authority.

5. Capacity & Technology Modification: During the contract period, the University may: ask to-

- Increase or reduce plant capacity, Add or remove chillers, Modify purification technology etc.
- Add/remove components including filters, membranes, pumps, UV systems, dosing systems, etc.
- The bidder shall comply with in specified time.
- Minor modifications shall be made without additional financial burden. Major changes involving cost shall be mutually agreed in writing.
- Decision of the University shall be final and binding.

6. Space Usage & Vacation: The space provided is purely temporary and for operational use only.

- No tenancy or lease rights shall arise
- The University may require the bidder to vacate the space
- Equipment must be removed within one month or as directed
- No compensation shall be payable
- Failure to vacate allows University to remove equipment at risk and cost of bidder

7. Performance Security: The successful bidder shall submit:

- Performance Security equal to 05% of one-year contract value Inform of FDR from Scheduled Bank
- Valid for minimum 36 months
- To be submitted within 10days of work order
- University may forfeit it partially or fully in case of default.
- EMD may be adjusted toward Performance Security.

8. Contract Period:

- Initial period: Comprehensive Warranty & Maintenance:
The bidder shall provide comprehensive maintenance and warranty for the entire contract period (minimum 2 years) including repair and replacement of defective components without any additional cost to the institution.
- Extendable by 1year based on performance
- Extension based on evaluation by Committee constituted by Competent Authority
- Decision of Competent Authority shall be final.
- Successful bidder must execute formal agreement on stamp paper of Rs 100/-.

9. Risk & Cost: If service provider fails to perform:

- University may arrange alternative service
- Additional cost shall be recovered from dues or security

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10. Penalty & Termination: University may:

- Impose financial penalty up to 10% of monthly rental for each exceeding downtime limit.
- Terminate contract for repeated non-performance
- Forfeit Performance Security
- Process of Blacklisting bidder from future tenders will be initiated .

11. Eligibility & Procurement Mode

- Mandatory site visit certificate required
- Bidder must be active on GeM portal
- Procurement shall be through GeM only

12. Legal Jurisdiction: All disputes shall be subject to jurisdiction of courts at Mathura.
