

Procedure for filling objections to Question and/or Key for UGEE 2026

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY

1. Check the OMR sheet by login to the portal as well as key properly.
2. If you find that the answer key is incorrect for any question, kindly identify the question number(s) along with the correct answer(s) for the respective question(s).
3. For example, you find that in **Set A**, the answer to question number 5 and 9 are incorrect.
4. Note down the question number, question and relevant answer given in key.
5. Deposit Rs. 250.00 per question as objection fees in following account (as per example at point 3, for two questions, Rs. 500.00 would be required to be deposited):
